Dense ruby to the rim and fuller-bodied than the Ventana Vineyard, it offers up beautiful layers of sweet kirsch, raspberry, and licorice, terrific fruit, a long, concentrated, opulent attack and mid-palate, and a velvety-textured finish. A bouquet of bacon fat, damp earth, tar, and spice emerges from the 2006 Syrah Dry Stack Vineyard. Abundant acidity results in a narrow mouthfeel as well as a tight, backward style.
