This is a serious, French-inspired effort displaying plenty of Mourvedre's unique character in both its aromas and flavors. The tannins are substantial, but civilized, and the wine offers a big, full-bodied mouthful of gamy, earthy, meaty Mourvedre. It should drink well for 7-8 years. Tel.
